- look after your child's safety and well-being,
- offer a broad, balanced and enriched curriculum, matched to the needs of your child and the National Statutory requirements,
- be welcoming to you, and offer you opportunities to become involved in the life of the school,
- make sure that all children and their families are treated with respect and sensitivity,
- provide a pleasant and stimulating environment in which your child can feel happy and valued, and which will enable them to learn, and fulfil their potential,
- contact you if we are concerned about your child's attendance or punctuality,
- contact you as soon as possible if we have worries about your child's work or behaviour,
- approach behaviour following the therapeutic approach as detailed in our Behaviour Policy,
- work with you to deal with any concerns or particular needs your child may have,
- set homework in accordance with the school's Homework Policy,
- keep you informed about the content of the school curriculum every half term in a letter to parents and carers and
- keep you fully informed about your child's progress.

The Parents/Carer will:

- work together with the school to try and make sure my child behaves well,
- ensure my child is ready to learn,
- see my child arrives at school on time, and is collected promptly at the end of the school day,
- avoid taking children away for holidays in term time,
- read the Behaviour Policy which can be found on our website,
- make every effort to support my child's learning at home, including daily reading whenever possible,
- talk to the school if my child is worried about attending school, or if something happens to affect my child's learning,
- attend consultation meetings and other school events in order to keep in touch with the school and my child's progress and
- talk to my child about this Home-School Agreement.

- behave well following our Rights Respecting Rainbow,
- bring my book bag and reading book to school every day and
