What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
<b><u>Literacy</u></b> We have been learning to write in sentences so that everyone can read our writing.	We have been busy writing about the jungle where the chapatti story is set. We have been thinking about ways that the chapatti could have escaped from the hungry tiger. We have been very inventive with our ideas. We also followed a recipe to make our own unique crumbles. We hope you enjoyed them. Please ask your child to taste them as we will be evaluating them in school next week. Thank you for your kind donations of fruit.	I could do some cooking at home using the seasonal fruit apple, plum, pear or blackberries. I could talk to you about how the Chapatti is so similar to the Gingerbread Man.
<b><u>Mathematics</u></b> We have been learning about the whole number and parts of a number.	We have been learning about whole items such as a whole banana and then we have been physically cutting it into 2 parts. We then looked at the number 5 and how we could split the number into 2 parts. 4 and 1, 3 and 2, 2 and 3 and 1 and 4. (We have not been using 0 and 5 at this point!)
