| <b><u>Literacy</u></b><br>We are learning to write instructions.                             | We talked about how we brush our teeth and wrote instructions to help Bog Baby. We also listened to our friends tell us instructions so we could draw a picture.<br>Bog Baby then disappeared so we made lots of posters to ask everyone in school to help us find him. 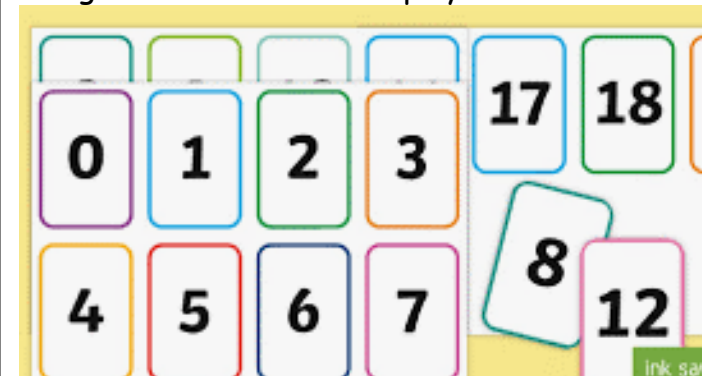
Talk about heavier and lighter as you are weighing the ingredients.

- Draw it on the floor in chalk
- Roll a marble in the shape of the number in playdough
- Use a paintbrush and paint a giant number using just water on a fence or on the ground.
- Make the number using string or wool.

Make up your own board game. You could use a board that goes up to 100. You could then find a way to go backwards as part of the game.

You could make cards which have the numbers 0-20 and make a pairs game with them. They can bring them into school to play with a friend.
