| What we wanted to learn  | What we did  | What I could do at home to help me with my learning  |
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| <b><u>Literacy</u></b><br>We were learning to write our ideas down in our Drawing Club book. | We came into school and found a trail of lots of blue things. It led us to a book by Jeanne Willis and a tiny creature called Bog Baby. We thought about what he may need to eat and where he may like to sleep. We wrote about the character. On Wednesday, we could not find him so we wrote about where he may have gone.               | You could draw a map of your route to school and label the different things you see on the way.<br>I could tell you about the trail, describing the different things I saw.<br>You can read your book to your grown-ups adding lots of expression. |
| <b><u>Mathematics</u></b><br>We were making patterns.  | We have been showing our teachers our maths skills. They were so proud of us and the maths that we knew. They loved the way we explain our thinking to show our maths knowledge.<br>We made patterns such as alternating the size or colour. We then tried to copy a pattern such as 2 yellow, 1 red, 2 yellow, 1 red, using the counters. | You could write the numbers from 0 to 9 to make sure you are writing them correctly.<br>You could count backwards when you go down the stairs.<br>You could make a pattern using things in your house such as pens or pegs.                        |
