<b><u>Literacy</u></b> We are learning to write clear sentences to share our ideas.	We found a magical tin in our classroom. It is a magical portal that Professor Clunk can communicate through. Our writing helps to power his Great Big Story Machine. We will be going on a special mission by writing lots of stories and poems. We hope we will meet some other characters next week too.	We could write our own story and bring it in to share with the class at story time. We could write our own poem based on the fireworks we have heard and seen this week.
<b><u>Mathematics</u></b> We are learning to say the number that is one more or one less than a given number.	We have been looking at the staircase the Numberblocks make when they stand in numerical order. We noticed that they go up when we add one and go down when we take off one. We have been saying a number such as 6 and then shouting one more. One more than 6 is .... 7! We have then said one less than 9 is ...8! We have been drawing part part whole model to show this maths. We have impressed all our teachers.  We have also been looking at odd and even numbers. Even numbers are made up of pairs or twos. Odd numbers have pairs sometimes but there is always an odd one with no pair. A bit like an odd sock.	We could say a number and find this many shoes or socks. Put them in pairs and see if there is an odd one. Is the number odd or even?
