Our Learning Journey - This week we have been sharing our knowledge of The Great Fire of London, ready for our learning next week.

What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
<u>Literacy</u> We have been learning to write sentences.	We learned about a new character in our Curious Quest called The Greap. They are a baddie. We thought of ways to capture The Greap by inventing lots of different contraptions.	We could write a sentence about something we did at school this week. Remember a full stop and capital letter! We could practise spelling the tricky words we have been learning this week.
Mathematics We are learning to make 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 using 5 and a bit.	We have been making the numbers 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 by using 5 and a bit. The picture here shows that 6 can be made with 5 and 1. 7 can be made with 5 and 2 more.  We started by <b>growing</b> the number - counting it out one finger at a time. Then we were able to <b>show</b> the number - show it on our fingers without counting.  Finally, we were able to <b>throw</b> the number so we can open our fingers and show the number without looking or counting!  You could ask us to show this to you.	We could try and guess which number you have. You could show one of your hands and hide the number 5 behind your back.  If I have 2 in front and 5 fingers behind, what number do I have? 7!
Science We have been learning to name objects and identify the materials they are made from.	We looked at different objects around the room. We thought about the materials they were made from. We used the stem sentence 'The object is, the material is'.	We could find all the things in our house that are made from plastic/wood/fabric/glass. We could sort objects according to their material - where would you put an object made of more than one material?

Word aware words: You could practise saying this word in a sentence or see if you can spot it in a book.
