



Our Learning Journey - This week we all took part in a drama workshop to learn facts about The Great Fire of London.

What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
<u>Literacy</u> We have been learning to write about The Great Fire of London.	We have been reading the book called 'The Great Fire of London'. We have been learning lots of facts. We then did our drama workshop which we all loved. We pretended to go back in time and explore what London was like and how people tried so hard to save the buildings from the fire.	We could go the library and borrow some books about The Great Fire of London. We could tell you some of the facts that we learned: When was the fire? 1666 Where did it start? In a bakery on Pudding Lane. How did it start? The fire was not put out properly. Why did the fire spread so quickly? The weather had been dry, it was very windy, so fire spread quickly, and many houses were made from wood with thatched roofs.
<u>Mathematics</u> We have been learning to identify odd and even numbers.	We looked at the numbers 1-10. We put them in order and looked at the pattern and shape of the numbers. We looked to see if they were in pairs. If all of the number could be paired, they were the even numbers. If there was an odd one left on its own, this was an odd number. We talked about an odd sock and that it did not have a pair. We investigated the even number 6 to see if it could only be made with even numbers.	 <p>Match the numbers</p>
<u>Science</u> We have been learning to name objects and identify the materials they are made from.	We looked at different objects around the room and thought about what they were made from. We all tried to find an object made of metal, glass, plastic, paper and wood. Some items had 2 or more materials in them. Some materials were easier to find such as plastic. We talked about why lots of our toys were not made from glass.	Look out for a thatched roof when you are out and about. Do you see lots of them? Why?
