



What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
<u>Literacy</u> We have been learning to use capital letters and full stops in a sentence.	We have been reading a fiction book about fire. We used our imagination to make creations for the boy in the story. We have been working really hard to use these words in our play and in our writing: flicker, ignite, dimmed, unique, extraordinary and inspiring.	We could practise writing fire, flames, flicker and ignite. We could tell you what our focus words mean. <u>Mathematics</u> We have been learning to make 10 using 2 numbers.	We have been looking at pairs of numbers that add to 10. We know that 10 and 0, 9 and 1, 8 and 2, 7 and 3, 6 and 4, 5 and 5, 4 and 6, 3 and 7, 2 and 8, 1 and 9, and 0 and 10 all add to 10.	We could write these numbers on bits of paper and match them up as fast as we can. We could write some part whole models to show you  which part is missing.
