<u>Literacy</u> We have been using adjectives to describe the fire.	We went onto the field and lit a fire. We looked closely at what we could see. We thought about what we could smell, hear and feel. We wrote adjectives to describe the fire. We created a word bank to help us write a poem for Michael Rosen about fire. We practised spelling the words: fire, flame, see, hear and smell. We also practised our handwriting so that our poems will look beautiful.	We could tell you about the fire using our senses to describe it. We could use adjectives to describe an object for you to guess. We could practise writing fire, flames, see, hear and smell.
Mathematics We have been learning about 2D shapes.	Thank you for the take home tasks that have been sent back. We have been learning the names and properties of these shapes: circle, triangle, square, rectangle, pentagon, hexagon, and octagon. We have been counting the number of sides and vertices (corners) on a shape. We noticed that often a shape has the same number of sides as vertices. We also noticed that a square is still a square even when it has its vertex pointing to the top.	We could make a picture using different shapes. We could go on a shape hunt and see how many circles, triangles, squares and rectangles we can see in our home.
