<b>Literacy</b> We wanted to practise our phonics.  We wanted to listen to stories.	We learnt the phonemes s a t and p We learnt the harder to read and spell words 'a'  We listened to the story 'What Makes Me a Me'. We talked about how we are all special.	I could look on Tapestry and say the sounds on the cards. I could practice writing the grapheme using the ditty I have learned. The ditties will be on Tapestry. I could practice forming the word 'a' in sand, paint or using chalk. I could find objects on the house that begin with s a t and p  I could tell you something that is really special about me. "I am really kind" or "I take turns in games" for example.
<b>Vocabulary</b> We wanted to develop our understanding of key concept vocabulary.	We were introduced to Concept Cat and learnt all about the concept 'front'. We took part in lots of activities to help us understand what 'front' means.	I could line up my toys and tell you which one is at the front. I could show you the front of food packets in my home.
<b>Other subjects</b> We wanted to learn about our Rights Respecting Rainbow. We wanted to learn about the right to play	We looked at the large rainbow in the hall and talked about why it is so important in our school. We learnt that the Rights Respecting Rainbow helps us learn about our rights and responsibilities in school and this helps us all have a happy, safe and kind school. We talked about the right to play and listened to a story about playing well.	I could show you how I can remember good manners. I could say please and thank you and use kind words when talking to you and my friends. I could colour in a rainbow and bring it into school to show my teacher.
