What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
<b>Literacy</b> We wanted to practise our phonics.	We have been learning the phonemes y, z, zz, qu and ch  We have been learning the harder to read and spell words 'we', 'me' and 'be' and putting our focus word into a sentence such as: "We can play in the park".	I could practice forming the graphemes y, z, zz, qu and ch in sand, paint or using chalk. I could begin to build words together using our learnt sounds. I could look for the words 'me', 'we' and 'be' in books that we share.
We wanted to learn about characters and settings in stories. We enjoyed Drawing Club.	This week we enjoyed listening to 'The Diddle that Dummed'. We all enjoyed retelling the story and joining in with repeated phrases. We learnt some new vocabulary and drew the character Flinty and the story setting (Flinty's Music Room!) Each drawing needed a secret code to unlock part of an adventure. This was either a mark, letter, word or caption.	I could talk to you about the vocabulary that we learnt this week - scribe, halt, leaped, exceptional, roared and searching. I could make my own Flinty character with playdough.
Vocabulary We wanted to develop our understanding of key concept vocabulary.	This week Concept Cat taught use the word 'out'. We took part in lots of activities to help us understand what 'out' means.	I could take a cuddly toy out of a box/ bath/ alternative container. I could go to the shops and take items out of the basket at the till.
Understanding of the World We wanted to take part in a Jolly Christmas Postman Workshop!	On Friday we all enjoyed a Jolly Christmas Postman workshop! We helped Postie Megan to tell the story and joined in while The Jolly Postman delivered Christmas cards and parcels to the fairy tale characters!	I could begin to write a letter to Father Christmas. I could use the Writing set to write some letters and bring them in to school to show my teacher!
