Our Learning Journey - This week we have been immersing ourselves in Dragon Poetry and getting ready for our trip next week!

What we wanted to learn:	What we did:	What could I do at home to help me with my learning?
<u>Literacy</u> To write expanded noun phrases. To use similes and alliteration in our descriptive writing. To use full sentences and edit independently.	We have read poems about dragons and have looked closely at the beautiful descriptions and vocabulary used in the book 'Tell me a Dragon'. We have learnt about adjectives and nouns and have written fantastic noun phrases to describe a dragon. We have written amazing sentences full of descriptive detail and edited our work independently as much as possible!	I could look at a picture of a dragon in a book or online and write labels using my senses. (Or I could draw my own dragon!) What might it smell like and why? What might it feel like and why? What colour is it? Does its habitat have something to do with its colour? Has this dragon adapted to its habitat? Has it grown bigger/smaller wings, longer talons or webbed feet? Does it breathe out something different instead of fire - why?
<u>Mathematics</u> I can add three addends under 10. I can use a first, then, now story to add three addends. I can explain that addends can be added in any order. I can add three addends efficiently	Addends are 3 numbers added together so we have been playing around with adding them using different mathematical equipment from our maths boxes. E.g $3 + 4 + 2 = 9$ We have been using number stories to add 3 addends. We have been spotting friendly numbers to make adding 3 part number sentences easier by using our number bonds to ten.	Can you come up with a 3 part number story and change the characters or numbers and see if you can add a number sentence underneath? <div><div>First there were 3 knights on the battlements. Then 1 more knight came up and then 4 more came to join them. How many knights are there now?</div><div></div></div>
