**Our Learning Journey** - This week we have been enjoying the story 'George and the Dragon' by Chris Wormell in our curious quests.

What we wanted to learn:	What we did:	What could I do at home to help me with my learning?
<b><u>Literacy</u></b> I can write a description of a character and a setting.  I can write my own adventure story.	We learnt that the giant fly trap was blocking our way and we needed to use an adjective in our writing so the faithful friend could get past.  We looked at a variety of characters and settings and described them. We also thought about what might happen if we met a dragon and wrote our own adventure stories.	Practice your handwriting remembering the lead in's for each letter.  Can you write the alphabet with beautifully formed letters?
<b><u>Mathematics</u></b> I can compare two, two-digit numbers. I can partition a two-digit number into tens and ones. I can add two, two-digit numbers by partitioning into tens and ones. I can add two, two-digit numbers using a calculation story.	We looked at part-whole models and sorting tens and ones.  We looked at number sentences linked to tens and ones and solved calculations.  We also used the language 'first, next, after' to tell maths stories and used practical equipment.	I could roll a dice and work out how many more to make 10.  I could pick a number and show you all the different ways I know to represent it. I could show my grown-ups to see if they knew all the ways that I did!
