




# Talk to me about

Date: Autumn Term 21st November 2025



Our Literacy focus this week has been writing our Rapunzel alternative tale and reading other fairy tales.

What we wanted to learn:	What we did:	What could I do at home to help me with my learning?
<p><b><u>Literacy</u></b></p> <p>Innovated up the story of Rapunzel to create a story plan.</p> <p>I wrote the beginning, middle and end of Rapunzel.</p> <p>I edited my Rapunzel story.</p>	<p>We read the story again of Rapunzel by Bethan Woollvin and broke down the story into the beginning, middle and end.</p> <p>We used fairy tale language, adjectives and conjunctions to write the beginning, middle and then ending of the story.</p> <p>We re-read our retelling of Rapunzel and checked our spellings, capital letters and full stops and added adjectives to make our writing even better.</p>	<p>Read or listen to different fairy tales.</p> <p>Who are the good characters?</p> <p>Who are the bad?</p> <p>Where is it?</p> <p>What is the problem in the story?</p> <p>How is it resolved?</p> <p>Can you say what is similar and different about them compared to Rapunzel?</p>
<p><b><u>Mathematics</u></b></p> <p>I can explain what the groups are made of.</p> <p>I can use knowledge of equal groups to apply it to repeated addition number sentences</p>	<p>This week we started looking at multiplication linked to groups and began to use the 'x' symbol linked into the language of groups of.</p> <p>We looked at lots of visual representations of these and used bar models and repeated addition to help us understand multiplication.</p> <p>Here are some examples of what we have done below...</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p><math>5 + 5 + 5</math></p> <p><math>3 \times 5</math></p> </div>	<p>Practise sorting items in equal groups and then using them to show how it can be represented by the 'x' symbol.</p> <p>For example, this...</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Means 4 groups of 2 which is <math>2 + 2 + 2 + 2</math></p>

Words we have been learning this week: door, floor, poor.

Word Aware: presenter, equation, beginning

Maths Mental Fluency: counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.
