




Our Literacy focus this week has been looking at an alternative telling of Little Red Riding Hood and understand the definition of a noun; noun phrases linked to adjectives.

What we wanted to learn:	What we did:	What could I do at home to help me with my learning?
<u>Literacy</u> We changed the good characters in the story. We thought of adjectives to describe a setting. We wrote noun phrases	We read the story of Little Red and imagined what we might encounter after the end of the books. We also wrote noun phrases to describe the wolf and a different bad character.	Can you think of adjectives to describe your favourite toy? You could draw your favourite toy and then write adjectives around it.
<u>Mathematics</u> I can explain what the groups are made of. I can use knowledge of equal groups to apply it to repeated addition number sentences I know equal groups can be written with a multiplication expression. We can solve number problems.	This week we started looking at multiplication linked to groups and begun to use the 'x' symbol linked it into the language of groups of. We looked at lots of visual representations of these and use bar models and repeated addition to help us understand multiplication. Here are some examples of what we have done below...  $5 + 5 + 5$ 3×5	Practise sorting items in equal groups and then using them to show how it can be represented by the x symbol. For example this...  Means 4 groups of 2 which is $2 + 2 + 2 + 2$ or 4×2 Try to group in 2's, 5's and 10's.
