What is our Home Learning Project for Pole to Pole?

To create an A4 fact page about an explorer of their choice. This will then be added to the class book so please make sure it is A4.



We will give you an A4 piece of paper to write on. We will then make it into a class explorer book

You may want to include:

- A heading with your explorer's name
- Sub-heading
- A photograph
- A timeline to show when they explored.
- Bullet points to explain where they went on their explorations.



You will need to research everything you can about your chosen subject and then decide how you are going to present that knowledge to your class.

You could add a map to show where your explorer went.

You could go to the library and get out books about the explorer.

Explain why you have chosen this explorer. Why are they remembered in history?
