What's been happening in school!

Year 1 have been fire making. We have been using our senses to see, hear, smell and feel the heat of the fire from a safe distance. We have used this experience to write our own poems about fire.

We have also been scientists to think about which materials are waterproof or absorbent. We used pipettes to test the materials. Some absorbed the water quickly and others took longer to absorb it so therefore they were more absorbent.

We are so proud of the Reception children. They have been working really hard to practise all of their songs and actions for the Nativity. Our dress rehearsal with Year 2 and Year 3 children from Southway was a huge success and they really enjoyed sharing it with you too! We have been getting into the festive spirit in Reception. We have been learning about the Christmas story and advent. We have also been doing lots of lovely Christmas crafts including making decorations and Christmas cards for our families. These will be sent home in the next few days.
