Literacy We wanted to practise our phonics. We wanted to learn about traditional tales and retell a story. We wanted to write words, captions and sentences.	We have been learning the Phase 3 sounds 'ow' prow and growl, 'ear' clear that smear, 'air' pair in the lair and 'oi' coin in the soil. This week we enjoyed watching the animation, 'Scooby Doo'. We all enjoyed retelling the story. We learnt some new vocabulary and drew the character Scooby and the story setting 'The Museum'. Each drawing needed a secret code to unlock part of an adventure. This was either a word, caption or sentence.	I could practice forming the graphemes ow, ear, oi and air in sand, paint or on my whiteboard. I could begin to build words together using our learnt sounds. I could talk to you about the vocabulary that we learnt this week - mystery, find, frightened, clues, solve and teamwork. The most important message was to always talk to a grown up and they will help us.	I could practise the song we learnt: Before you Tap and Click You need to stop and think And TELL Someone!
Design and Technology We wanted to design a new biscuit.	We tasted three different types of biscuit: ginger, cinnamon and lemon. We chose the flavour we liked most and then designed a new biscuit with decorations.	I could talk to you about the biscuit flavour that I liked the most. I could talk to you about my design.
