




Our Learning Journey - this week we have been continuing with our Arctic adventures story using Lost and Found for inspiration

What we wanted to learn:	What we did:	What could I do at home to help me with my learning?
<p>To write the beginning of the story.</p> <p>To write the middle of the story.</p>	<p>We wrote an Arctic adventure story using 'Brave and the Fox' and lost and found for ideas.</p> <p>We used our story plan to remember the key parts. We tried to use powerful words and phrases to make our writing sound exciting.</p> <p>We edited our writing with a purple polishing pen to check that our sentences made sense, that we remembered capital letters and full stops and to see if we could add any extra words to improve our sentences.</p> 	<p>I could read other stories that are set in a cold climate. Compare them to 'Brave and the Fox'. What are the similarities and the differences?</p> <p>I could write my own story about someone getting lost. How could they find their way home?</p>
<p><b>Mathematics</b></p> <p>To use division to solve problems.</p>	<p>We looked at different ways to share objects and recapped the division symbol.</p> <p>We spoke about new vocab to explain division too... see below. We were so impressed with their understanding.</p> <p>As your children what these mean:</p> <p>Dividend = the whole amount</p> <p>Divisor = how many in each group</p> <p>Quotient= how many equal groups</p> 	<p>Write some division facts where you can share between 2, 5 and 10 and then make them with items like pencils, pens, coins and see how many groups you have.</p> <p>Link it back to the times tables.</p>

Maths Mental Fluency: quick recall of times tables facts for 2, 5 and 10.
