Our Learning Journey - This week we have all made our moving space pictures - thank you so much for your help.

What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
<u>Literacy</u> We are learning to use the suffix 'ing' when the root word does not change. Such as look, see, think, hear	Thank you for coming in to make the DT space pictures with us. We could not have done it without you. The children have been making even more moving pictures in class. This week we have been reading a book called 'On the Moon'. It has given us a chance to revisit all the knowledge we learned in history and apply it in our writing. We have been learning the suffix 'ing' so we have been writing sentences such as 'I am standing here looking at the stars'.	We could write our own book about space. You could find out more facts and tell us in school.
<u>Mathematics</u> We have been learning to add and subtract. We have looked at the inverse operation.	We created subtraction number stories using first, then and now: First , there were 6 people on the bus, then 3 got off, now there are 3. We used our number facts to help us to solve the problems. We made addition stories too and solved them. We then looked at how the add and subtract are opposites. We talked about the inverse operations below by telling stories and solving problems. $3 + 4 = 7$ $7 - 4 = 3$	We could solve subtraction number problems by telling a story. Can you then check your answer by adding?
<u>Science</u> We were learning about planet Earth	We had a visit from Sarah and Simon Cook who are geologists. They showed us fossils that were millions of years old, we did experiments and we learned about different earth types. We all loved it. The awe and wonder on the children's faces was wonderful for us to see.	We could look at a famous scientist and find out what they have taught us about the world.

Word aware words:

You could practise saying this word in a sentence or see if you can spot it in a book. **gravity** **weightless**

Maths Mental Fluency: 8 or not? Show a group of objects - is it 8 or not, how do you know? Remember odd and even to help you. How many ways can you make 8 using 2 numbers? $8 + 0$, $7 + 1$, $6 + 2$ etc
