What is a take home task?

A take home task is a home learning project, a short activity for you and your child to carry out at home together over the next half term. We would like you to help your child to develop their ideas over the next few weeks to produce the best project that they can. Please could your child bring their bean diary into school by **Monday 23rd March**. Please do not bring the plant in as it may get broken

What is our Home Learning Project?

Plant your seed and watch it as it grows. You could use a yoghurt pot or other recycled container to grow it in. If you need compost, please bring your pot into school and we will fill it for you.



How much is your plant growing each week?

What will your project look like?

You could take photos each week to see how it has changed.
You could measure your plant and explain how tall it is each week.
You may choose to make a video diary so you can tell us about the changes you are observing.
You could draw what your plant looks like each week and label the different parts of your plant.

What are the first signs that your seed is growing?

What is happening under the soil? Why?

Where do the first leaves come from?

Which colours can you see on your plant?

Do the first leaves that grow look like the next leaves that grow?
