What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
<p>Literacy We wanted to practise our phonics.</p> <p>We wanted to write captions and sentences in Drawing Club.</p>	<p>This half term is all about review and consolidate. We have been reading and spelling lots of words and captions containing sounds we have learnt. We learnt the new harder to read and spell words, 'were', 'out', 'like'.</p> <p>This week we have continued to enjoy the book 'The Tiger Who Came To Tea'. We confidently used the new vocabulary we learnt last week and drew two new adventures - 'The tiger wants to join the family at the café. What food does he eat?' and 'The tiger is travelling on the tiger bus'. Each drawing needed a secret code to unlock part of an adventure. This was either a word, caption or sentence.</p>	<p>I could practice saying a sentence with the word 'said' in. I could write 'were', 'out' and 'like' really big, really small and using different coloured pens or pencils.</p> <p>I could create another new adventure for the tiger I wonder?- The zoo have come looking for the tiger. Where can he hide?</p>
<p>Mathematics We wanted to compare mass and capacity.</p>	<p>We picked up lots of objects and talked about whether they were heavy or light. We compared the weight of objects using the words heavier and lighter. We used balance scales to compare objects and learnt that heavy objects make the scales tip. We used cubes as a unit of measure to find the mass of classroom objects. For example, the mass of a pine cone is six cubes. We filled lots of different containers in different ways and talked about whether they were full or empty. We explored capacity using different materials such as water, sand and rice. We investigated capacity using different sized containers.</p>	<p>I could find objects around the house that are heavier or lighter than an apple. I could compare them using my hands or balance scales and talk about what I know.</p> <p>I could bake some biscuits this weekend and use the kitchen scales to weigh the ingredients.</p> <p>I could explore filling different cups with liquid. I could make a full glass, an empty glass, a glass that is nearly full and a glass that is nearly empty? I could fill different containers and tell you which container has the greatest capacity,</p>
<p>Other subjects We wanted to enjoy books and World Book Day!</p>	<p>We dressed up as a book character or wore pyjamas and enjoyed lots of different World Book Day activities!</p>	<p>We could take a trip to the library as a family and I could tell you all about it and enjoy sharing some lovely stories</p>
