<p><u>Literacy</u> We learned to write in full sentences. We learned to make plurals by adding s or es.</p>	<p>We read a book called 'Jack and the Baked Beanstalk'. It is set in a city. The Baked Beanstalk grows up to the sky, and the giant is very lonely. He is a wonderful chef so when the beanstalk accidentally breaks, he stays with Jack and they cook delicious food in Jack's café.</p>	<p>We could tell you all about the story or do a puppet show about it. We could start to learn some jokes for Comic Relief.</p>
<p><u>Mathematics</u> We learned to count items to 100!</p>	<p>We learned that when we are counting, it is more efficient to count in tens and then to count the extra ones. 42 - We would count 10, 20, 30, 40.....41, 42.</p>	<p>We could count forwards in 10s from 10 to 100. We could count items such as buttons and coins. Count them into piles of tens and the extra ones. You could then say the number and write it down.</p>
