Our Learning Journey This week we have been taking part in a Multi-skills competition.

What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
Literacy We are learning to write in full sentences. We are learning to proof-read.	We read a book called 'Goldilocks and just one bear'. The bear gets lost in the city and ends up in a home that belongs to Goldilocks. He causes all sort of problems, just like Goldilocks did when she was little in his house. It is a brilliant book.	We could check our writing by reading it back out loud. If you pause as you are reading it, you may need to add in a full stop, exclamation mark or question mark.
Mathematics We have been learning to find a number on a number-line.	We continued to count forward and backwards in tens. We remembered that the word sixty means there are six tens; ty means tens. We looked at a number on the linear number-line. We found the number by identifying the tens either side of that number. 29 is between 20 and 30.	We could count forwards and backwards in tens. You could say a multiple of 10 and then say ten more or ten less. We could find a number and tell you a number that is one more or one less than that number.
