<p>Literacy To use conjunctions like but, so, and, or. To write creatively. To check our writing and think of a next step when we write again.</p>	<p>We read 'The Big Dark' and looked at where we could send Chinoo to if we could send him anywhere in our imagination, as he was bored of the big dark.</p> <p>We thought of where the walrus character could escape to.</p> <p>We also gave Chinoo a new friend and wrote about what they did together, all the time using conjunctions.</p> <p>We wrote our own creative writing ideas and made sure to include capital letters, full stops and conjunctions.</p>	<p>Can you try and write about the adventures you have over the holidays and try to use conjunctions like but, so, and, or to extend the sentences.</p>
<p>Mathematics To choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure mass/weight. Looking at Kg/g Using Scales</p>	<p>We used bucket balances and scales to measure and compare items by weight.</p> <p>We looked at mass in grams and then kilograms.</p> <p>We read scales in increments of 1, 2, 5 and 10.</p> <p>We answered word problems about mass.</p>	<p>Go home and read scales for cooking.</p> <p>Notice how many grams or kilograms an item is by looking at a packet. Compare objects from heaviest to lightest.</p> <p>How many kg are you, who is the lightest/heaviest?</p>

Words for this week: parents, was, school, because (**Challenge:** Can you put all of these words into a silly sentence? Write the sentence and check the spelling of these words. Remember your punctuation!)

Word Aware: elated perseverance. Ask your children what these words mean - can they put them into a sentence?

Maths Mental Fluency: practise quartering a number by halving and halving again. E.g to work out a quarter of 12, I would halve it once to get 6 and then halve it again to get 3.
