Some ideas:

- A local farm.
- Show us a route where you can take a walk and see the beautiful scenery in our local area.
- Describe a club that you attend and tell us what you learn there and why you enjoy it so much.
- A place of worship that you may visit.

When you make your poster you could add:

- ⇒ a title
- ⇒ subheadings if you need to
- ⇒ bullet points to make the facts easier to read
- ⇒ photos
- ⇒ facts
- ⇒ Did you know...?
- ⇒ questions
- ⇒ A map or an address

You could take a photograph of the area or search for pictures of your chosen place with a grown-up on the internet.

You could describe why the place is so special. Be persuasive and tell us the benefits of visiting this place.
