## What is a take home task?

A take home task is a home learning project, a short activity for you and your child to carry out at home together over the next half term. We would like you to help your child to develop their ideas over the next few weeks to produce the best project that they can. Please could your child bring their take home task into school by **Friday 15th May**. If you do finish the project sooner, then please bring it into school.

## What is our Home Learning Project?

Please create a sea creature using any items that would have otherwise been thrown away.

You could take materials from your recycling bin to create any sea creature of your choice.



## What will your project look like?

It will reuse materials that might otherwise have been thrown away or recycled.

You could make a collage of a creature using different coloured card or paper found in your recycling bin.

You could make a dolphin from a bottle.



Use the internet to find out about the animal you are making.

How can you make it look just like a real sea creature?

You could make it from rubbish found on the beach. Make sure you are safe and cared for if you collect rubbish from the beach. Ask your grown ups if the rubbish is safe to pick up. Please stay safe near the water too.
