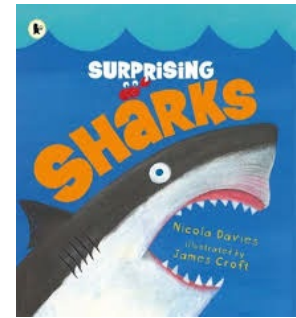


SOS

Save Our Seas

Summer 1



We will start the learning journey by learning about sharks. We will use the book "Surprising Sharks" by Nicola Davies to learn shark facts and write our own facts. We will then look at other creatures that live in rock pools so we know lots about the animals when we visit the beach on our trip on 21st May. Later this half term, the children will listen and respond to poetry connected to the sea and the creatures living there.

In Maths, we will be reading and writing the tricky teen numbers, adding and subtracting within 20, measuring height and length and introducing multiplication with 2, 5 and 10.

We will be practising our striking and fielding skills in cricket during PE and creating sequences in gymnastics on the floor and on apparatus.

In Geography, we be looking at the difference between villages, towns and cities. We will look at different coastal locations and compare them. We will re-visit our learning on human and physical features, thinking about the features of a seaside.



In Design and Technology, we will be exploring different joining techniques. We will design, make and evaluate our own sea creature puppets. We will be asking parents and carers to come and help with making our puppets on these dates at 9am:

Monday 11th May – Nightingales

Tuesday 12th May – Blackbirds

Wednesday 13th May - Woodpeckers

In Science, we are growing sunflower seeds in school. We will look at the lifecycle of a plant and learn about what plants and trees need to grow.

In PSHE, we will be looking at the right to be listened to and think about how we can do this at home and in school. We will also explore how to, 'feel safe and to feel good.' We will talk about how to recognise different feelings, what to do if you are feeling worried and how to keep yourself safe. We will learn the names of parts of the body and talk about the parts of the body that are private.

We will continue to use Purple Mash in Computing to learn about coding. During Music sessions, the children will continue to learn the recorder. We will also be using musical skills to perform and compose patterns.

In RE, we will be learning about Islam. We will learn about the things that are important to Muslims, where they worship and all about the Five Pillars of Islam.
