What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
<p>Literacy/Science We wanted to write captions and sentences in Drawing Club.</p>	<p>This week we have been reading 'Superworm'. We all enjoyed retelling the story and joining in with repeated phrases. We learnt some new vocabulary and drew Superworm (character) and created a new monster for the story (adventure). Each drawing needed a secret code to unlock part of an adventure. This was either a word, caption or sentence.</p>	<p>I could talk to you about the new vocabulary; zooming, courageous, indestructible, wriggling, calamity and transform. I could draw one of the characters from 'Superworm'. I could create my own secret code that will make Superworm fly through the air!</p>
<p>Mathematics We have been revisiting counting - knowing how many there are.</p>	<p>We practised counting children one by one. We used a counting wand to help us. Our class maths puppet helped but he made some mistakes such as saying the number words in the wrong order; 'tagging' children more than once; forgetting to stop and going around again; and not knowing how many children there are 'altogether' when asked. We helped 'Maths Monkey', 'Mathsy' and Mr Chicken to count accurately.</p>	<p>I could make my own counting wand and count objects around the home and garden. I could practice counting things that cannot be seen. For example, <i>I wonder who can stand on one leg for the longest time? Let's count together!</i></p>
<p>Science We wanted to learn about the life cycle of a butterfly.</p>	<p>We read the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and sequenced the story. We made our own story maps. We learnt about the life cycle of a butterfly and named the different stages of the cycle.</p>	<p>I could draw the life cycle of a butterfly and tell you each stage. I could tell you why it is called a life cycle.</p>
