What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
<p>Literacy/Science We wanted to write captions and sentences in Drawing Club.</p>	<p>This week we have been continuing to read 'Superworm'. We all enjoyed retelling the story and joining in with repeated phrases. We revised the vocabulary and created two new Superworm adventures. Each drawing needed a secret code to unlock part of an adventure. This was either a word, caption or sentence.</p>	<p>I could talk to you about the new vocabulary; zooming, courageous, indestructible, wriggling, calamity and transform. I could draw one of the characters from Superworm. I could create my own secret code that will make the wizard lizard fall into a cauldron of gloop!</p>
<p>Mathematics We wanted to learn to subitise complex arrangements. We wanted to develop our visualising skills.</p>	<p>We looked at dot arrangements and said if we could see 6 or not 6. We made a collection of 6 objects and put them in patterns or arrangements that were easy to subitise. We learnt even numbers can make doubles and we subitised doubles on tens frames.</p>	<p>I could use some small toys to use to make collections of 6 small objects. Then you could check that I can subitise the objects shown. <i>Do you have 6 things?</i> If this proves tricky, I could reduce the amount to be collected and build on the skill. You could show me some structured ways to show 6, e.g. a die pattern arrangement. I could close my eyes while you add or remove an object. <i>Which collection still contains 6 objects? Which do not? How do you know? Do you need to count?</i></p>
<p>Art We wanted to learn how to print.</p>	<p>We talked about the artist Giuseppe Archimboldo - he liked to use fruit and vegetables to make portrait pictures. We learnt to use vegetables to make pictures by pressing the vegetables in paint and then pressing down to make a print.</p>	<p>I could use some vegetables or fruit at home and make a print.</p>
