<p>Literacy</p> <p>To order a text</p> <p>To learn a recipe</p> <p>To write a recipe</p> <p>To edit my work</p>	<p>We continued with our story stimulus 'The Disgusting Sandwich' by Gareth Edwards.</p> <p>We ordered a disgusting recipe for how to make the sandwich and learnt it with actions and pictures to help us remember it.</p> <p>We then wrote our own version of the disgusting recipe and edited our work to make sure it made sense and read our recipes to our friends to see which one was the most disgusting!</p>	<p>With my adult, I could follow a recipe to make something delicious. I could play close attention to how the recipe is written and pick out the key features.</p> <p>https://www.foodafactoflife.org.uk/5-7-years/ is a good place to go for child appropriate recipes to follow.</p>
<p>Mathematics</p> <p>To find half of a shape and number.</p> <p>To find a quarter of a shape.</p> <p>To find a third of a number.</p>	<p>We looked at different fractions and learnt about the numerator (the number at the top of the fraction that tells us how many parts of the fraction we have) and denominator (the number at the bottom of the fraction which tells us how many pieces the whole has been cut into). We learnt that if the numerator is just one, it is called a unit fraction but if the numerator is a different number, it is called a non-unit fraction.</p> <p>We have been finding a half and a quarter of shapes.</p> <p>We shared out counters into 3 equal groups. We found out that some numbers could not be split into thirds and some numbers could.</p>	<p>I could find a half, quarter, a third of shapes. You may be able to find half of your lunch or dinner such as half a sandwich or half of a pizza!</p>
