What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
<p>Literacy We wanted to practise our phonics.</p> <p>We wanted to write captions and sentences in Drawing Club.</p>	<p>This week we have been learning to read and spell words containing er and est endings.</p> <p>This week we watched 'Bananaman' again. We all enjoyed retelling the story and joining in with repeated phrases. We recapped the vocabulary we had learnt and created two new adventures for Bananaman. We created number and written codes for both adventures.</p>	<p>I could practice reading and spelling these words longer, longest, quicker, quickest, brighter, brightest</p> <p>I could watch an episode of Bananaman https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=nz8XTi4nc5Y and draw and then create a new adventure - 'Can you create a way for Doctor Gloom to get about as a baby!' I could extend my sentence with the word 'and'.</p> <p>I could try saying a sentence out loud with one of our new vocabulary words or write them in a sentence or caption; gloomy, muscular, sinister, gulp, transformation and victorious.</p>
<p>Mathematics</p> <p>We wanted to compare numbers and focussed on ordinality - where numbers to 10 are in relation to each other.</p>	<p>We ordered the Numberblocks on a Number Track and explored the idea that numbers are getting bigger as we move along the track and of the linear increase in the numbers (the idea that each number on the track is 1 more than the previous number and 1 less than the following number). We enjoyed playing lots of track games.</p>	<p>I could play a track game with you at home using the number track that I am bringing home today. We could play dice games using a collection of small objects (e.g. blocks, shells, etc.) and 2 soft toys. Roll a die and ask me to give that many objects to the first toy. Roll the die again and give that number of objects to the second toy. <i>Who has the most? How do you know? What happens when we roll the die again? Who has more objects now?</i></p>
<p>Art</p> <p>We wanted to learn about Henri Matisse and his famous piece of art 'The Snail'</p>	<p>We learnt about the famous artist Henri Matisse and looked at his most famous painting. We read the book 'Snail Trail' and learnt about a collage technique Matisse used which was known as 'painting with scissors'. We looked at his work 'Snail' and created our very own piece of art in this style.</p>	<p>I could have a go at making a collage in the style of Henri Matisse. I could choose an animal, and using scissors, paper and glue create a collage using the painting with scissors technique!</p>
