What is a take home task?

A take home task is a home learning project, a short activity for you and your child to carry out at home together over the next half term. We would like you to help your child to develop their ideas over the next few weeks to produce the best project that they can. Please could your child bring their take home task into school by **Monday 13th July**.



You could make a PowerPoint or poster of animal facts.

David Attenborough, a famous naturalist, turned 100 this year. Find out as much as you can about your favourite creature.



You can share the information about your animal in any way that you choose. The ideas on this sheet are only suggestions.

You could make a model of an animal and write any interesting facts about it in a booklet.

Some things that you might like to think about:

What does your animal eat?

Is it a mammal, reptile, amphibian, bird or fish?

Where does it live?

Does it have any special features?

Is it a carnivore, herbivore or omnivore?

You could make a video containing information about an animal.



You could draw or paint an animal and write some 'Did you know?' boxes with interesting facts.



You could create a picture with sliders, levers or flaps with interesting facts on them.
