

# Beside the seaside



We started the learning journey by sharing photos from our beach trip in Ovingdean. We will then learn about the seaside in the past and think about how Brighton has changed over time. We will look at Martha Gunn as a local historical figure.

In P.E. we will be developing our gym and athletics skills. We will use our P.E. skills during Sports Day which is on 18<sup>th</sup> June. (Reserve date is 2<sup>nd</sup> July in case of rain.)

In Maths, we will be learning fractions and dividing in half. We will learn about halves and quarters, and this will help us to tell the time to half past and o'clock. We will also learn directional language.

We will look at the importance of prayer in Christianity and Islam during our R.E. sessions. We will also look at meditation and how people reflect in a non-religious way.

In PSHE, we will look at families, friends and how to resolve conflicts. We will also continue our learning on body parts.

During Music sessions, the children will learn to sing new songs, play the glockenspiels to accompany them and perform their songs.

In Computing, we will look at technology around us.

In Science, we will build on our learning about plants and trees. We will learn about deciduous and evergreen trees. We will name some flowers, plants and trees in our school grounds.

In Art, we will learn different printing techniques, including mono-printing, string printing and relief printing. We will use these skills to print on a re-usable bag. We would like to invite you in to help your child do the printing on these dates:
