What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
<p>Literacy We wanted to practise our phonics.</p> <p>We wanted to learn about characters and settings in stories. We enjoyed Drawing Club.</p>	<p>We have been learning the phonemes ay, ou, ie, and ea.</p> <p>We have been learning the harder to read and spell words 'oh' and 'their' and putting our focus word into a sentence such as: It is their turn to play on the bikes.</p> <p>This week we enjoyed listening to 'The Naughty Bus'. We all enjoyed retelling the story and joining in with repeated phrases. We learnt some new vocabulary and drew the character Naughty Bus and an adventure - The Naughty Bus has got himself stuck! Where is he stuck? Mud? A spiders web? A trap door? A sinking hole? A bowl of slime? Each drawing needed a secret code to unlock part of an adventure. This was either a word, caption or sentence.</p>	<p>I could practice forming the graphemes ay, ou, ie and ea in sand, paint or using chalk. I could begin to build words together using our learnt sounds. I could look for the words 'oh' and 'their' in books that we share.</p> <p>I could talk to you about the vocabulary that we learnt this week - speedy, adventure, cheeky, exhausted, mischief and cozy. I could make my own Naughty Bus with playdough.</p>
<p>Mathematics We wanted to recall number facts rapidly.</p> 	<p>We used rekenreks for the first time this week. We used them to push across given amounts and say how we knew what we had pushed. We use 'one finger, one push' to move a number of beads on the top row ALL AT ONCE to the far left of the rekenrek.</p>	<p>I could talk to you about how I used the rekenrek. I could show you on an online rekenrek https://mathsbot.com/manipulatives/rekenrek</p> <p>Please set the rekenrek to 2 rows 10 beads.</p>
<p>Understanding of the World We wanted to compare old and new vehicles</p>	<p>We talked about the vehicles that we had seen at Amberley and looked at photos of old cars, buses and trains. We talked about what was the same and what was different.</p>	<p>I could tell you how we travel differently today. You could tell me about the vehicles you travelled on when you were a child.</p>
