What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
Literacy We wanted to write sentences.	This week we have been reading 'Emma Jane's Aeroplane'. We all enjoyed retelling the story and joining in with repeated phrases. We learnt some new vocabulary and drew Emma Jane (character) and created a new adventure for her). Each drawing needed a secret code to unlock part of an adventure. This was either a word, caption or sentence.	I could talk to you about the new vocabulary; voyage, ocean, adventuring, navigate, directions, propellor. I could draw one of the characters from Emma Jane's Aeroplane or one of the cities she visited with her animal friends. I could create my own secret code that will make Emma Jane fly through to another incredible city!
Maths We wanted to compare amounts.	We used dice frames to make 5 in different ways. We played a game on our fingers of show me one more and show me one less. We used the rekenreks to find one more and one less. We used the stem sentence 5 needs _____ to make _____.	We could play a barrier game using up to 10 counters (or small objects). <i>I've got (e.g.) 8 counters altogether. I'm going to hide some under this cloth. How many can you see? How many are hidden? How do you know? Can you show me on your fingers? Are there still 8 altogether?</i> We could sing songs that feature numbers to 5 and 10, for example, when the children are lining up. <i>How many children have gone/are left?</i>
Design and Technology We wanted to learn to sew.	We recapped all we knew about joining materials. We talked about how you can sew by hand or on a machine. We learnt to use the needle and fabric scissors safely. We then learnt how to thread a needle. We had a go at sewing on a piece of Binca.	You could show me your sewing machine or home sewing kit and talk about how the machine works. I could try to spot the needle! We could talk about what is in the sewing kit and what it is used for. You could help me to thread a needle, and I can show you how I know to use this tool safely.
