What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
<u>Literacy</u> We were learning to ask questions.	We have been reading the book called 'Open Very Carefully'. It is a book about a crocodile that has got stuck in a story book. He is trying to get out. The author asks lots of questions to ask us how to help it! We have worked really hard to write questions and to include a question mark at the end. We looked at key question words that might start a question.	We could write 3 questions for you to answer. Make sure we have a question mark.
<u>Mathematics</u> We were learning quarters.	We have been learning to make a quarter of a shape by splitting it into 4 equal parts and then colouring in just one part. We have been finding a quarter of an amount by sharing equally into 4 groups and looking at just one of these groups.	We could find half and a quarter of amounts such as coins or buttons.
