What we wanted to learn	What we did	What I could do at home to help me with my learning
<u>Literacy</u> We were learning to find adjectives when we were reading. We were learning to write adjectives in our sentences.	We have been reading a book called 'The Girl with a Parrot on Her Head' by Daisy Hirst. We have spent time describing the characters, objects and places in the book. We have been working hard to describe how these things might smell, feel, sound, look or even taste.	We could describe something in the room using adjectives and you have to guess what it is.
<u>Mathematics</u> We were continuing to learn to describe turns and positions. We have been learning months of the year.	We have been looking at full, half, quarter and three quarter turns. We have been learning left and right, forward and backwards. We have been rotating items and moving items using these directions. We have been recapping the days of the week and now we are learning the months of the year in order.	We could look at the clock and decide how much of a turn the minute hand has made. We could direct someone to a certain place using verbal directions. We could sing the days of the week song.
