To order events in a story. To act out a story.	We read and watched the film 'The Bear' by local author Raymond Briggs. We acted out the story and watched the video to help us with our actions. We ordered the story and wrote speech bubbles as to what the girl and the bear could be saying.	Read comic books with talking characters and speech bubbles and make up your own comics to share with your adults at home.
Mathematics I know that doubling is using the 2 times tables I can double 2 digit numbers I can halve numbers. I understand the relationship between doubling and halving. I can answer word problems to solve these topics.	We explored the concepts of doubling linked to the 2 times tables. We took part in practical activities linked to money. We also looked at how halving is the opposite of doubling and used this knowledge to halve two digit numbers. We then solved word problems around this topic.	I could use objects at home to make double or half the amount groups. I could draw them or take a photo. I could use the stem sentence to describe them. I could write the number sentences and expressions they make. e.g $2 \times 4 = 4 + 4 = 8$
<u>Words for this week:</u> move, prove, improve, eye, busy <u>Phonics:</u> we have been recapping all of the sounds that we have learnt this term and practised writing our summer term spellings into super sentences. <u>SPAG:</u> we have been focusing on quality sentences and making sure that our handwriting letters have clear ascenders (k, l, h) and descenders (g, p, y) <u>Maths Mental Fluency:</u> Please revise taking away a single digit from any 2 digit number.
